






how do you rate the allocation of credits and hours to the courses?






How do you assess the various papers in terms of their relevance to the specialization streams?








The level of preparedness of the teachers for the classes









Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers 687 responses











 $_{\text{HoW}}$ do you rate the learning resources that are available in the college? $_{\text{6B responses}}$

53.9% student rate syllabus of the course expected to teaching-learning process.




- 55.6% students considers that the allocation of credits and hours to courses is average.












SUMMARY ANALYSIS:

- 75% of faculty strongly agrees that syllabus gives teachers to adopt new techniques of teaching.









The Course Simulate my ward's interest & thoughts on subject 48 responses



The syllabus of course is actually enriching?




Does syllabus provides hands on experience? 43 responses

- 66.7% parents rated good about hands on experience.











There is gap between industry requirement and curriculum implementation 12 responses




