


How do you assess the various papers in terms of their relevance to the specialization streams?






SUMMARY ANALYSIS:


- 70.4% of students rate the syllabus as per industry.










Rate the curriculum in term of securing Job 53 responses








There is gap between industry requirement and curriculum implementation




Curriculum advisory board should have industry representatives
