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Report on 'How to make your class Experiential'



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Report on 21st century skills



Keynote Speaker was Mr. Nachiket Joshi Founder Director - Experiential Education Lab







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
REPORT ON RESEARCH WEBINAR

Production & Total Quality Management, Business Research Methods, Change Management & Training & Development, Finance, Tourism Marketing, Event Marketing, Integrated Marketing Communications, Principles of Marketing, Principles of Management, Entreneurship management

- 1. Discussion on most important and least important topic was covered.
- 2. The methodology of clubbing 2 or 3 marks questions together by mixing the important questions with easy questions.
- 3. Some faculties raised the issue they are facing in specialized subjects like Tourism, Event Marketing, they informed that they do not get clear idea of important topics in the given subject and feel many topics may be irrelevant to the subject.

- It was decided to put fill in the blanks and true or false for objectives for 15 marks.
- One theory question should be asked in a simple manner so that students can attempt and can score the marks in the examination.

Foundation Course

• Students can be taught by giving various activities of relevant topic. Also they can be asked to make case studies of respective topics.

For all Theory subjects:





- Faculties discussed that they provide students with model papers for objectives before exams wherein more than 50 fill ups and True/False are given.
- Maximum portion should be targeted i.e. around 40-50% of portion for internals (2 modules) to reduce burden in last.
- There are lots of subjects with same topics having repetitive explanations. All faculties discussed about repetition and solution to it.
- More scoring questions are given in exams, which have diagrams, pointers and are easy to explain.
